"Happy Holidays" Exhibit

The Lubbock Arts Alliance would like to invite the members of the West Texas Watercolor Society to participate in an inaugural "Happy Holidays" exhibit. This is an invitational art show.

"Happy Holidays" will be exhibited at The Legacy Event Center, 1500 14th Street, from December 2015 to January 2016. The opening will be on Friday, December 4th from 6PM-8PM as part of the Arts Alliance's annual holiday event which features seasonal drinks & sweets and artwork from the **ARTadventures!** program which serves low income, minority children with art and music lessons at the Guadalupe Parkway Centers. **ARTadventures!** is underwritten by the Lubbock Arts Alliance.

Guidelines for "Happy Holidays":

Art must have subject matter(s) relating to the holidays and/or the winter season. The work does not have to be religious in nature, but such submissions are welcome.

No entry fee.

Must be 2-D water media work, no oils.

Maximum of three (3) entries per artist.

Can be an existing work of art, but cannot have been seen at the prior WTWS "Red" shows at the Legacy Event Center.

Artwork does not have to be for sale, but can be if the artist desires. Artwork that is sold is subject to the guidelines and policies of the Legacy Event Center including a 20% commission taken from the artwork's base price (price before sales tax is applied). The artist must have a Texas Sales & Use Tax ID# and is responsible for remitting the sales tax to the Texas Comptroller's office. The Legacy Event Center will process art sales.

All artwork must be wired, ready to hang; no sawtooth hangers.

Artwork needs to be delivered to the Legacy Event Center on Monday, November 23rd from noon-3PM.

Ribbons will be given for Best of Show, 1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place.

FROM BARBARA ROLLO:I am a former member of WTWS, moved away from Lubbock last December.

I'm the coordinator of EnPleinAirTEXAS, a national plein air competition being held in San Angelo, Texas the last week in October. We have 35 juried artists who hail from 14 states and one from Nova Scotia who will paint all week on location and compete for \$13,000 in prize money in an exhibit that weekend. One of your members, Tim Oliver, is one of the 35 juried artists! Last year he won 3rd Place in the Quick Draw, and I encouraged him to submit an application this year. It's just fantastic that he will have this experience.

Many of these award-winning artists will be giving free talks and demos on Friday, Oct 30, and we are hosting a 2 hour Paint-Out open to any artist on Saturday, Oct. 31, 10am to noon. The website is www.enpleinairTEXAS.com, and will give you all of the information, but I have also attached a flyer with some of the artwork from last year and a very quick overview of the event. If it's possible to spread the word, there may be some artists who want to come to San Angelo to watch or participate in the Saturday event.
