

2020 SPRING SHOW PROSPECTUS

The West Texas Watercolor Society 2020 Spring Exhibition will be held from April 3 - 25, 2020 at the Lubbock Municipal Garden and Arts Center (GAC), 4215 University Avenue, Lubbock, Texas.

ELIGIBILITY / SHOW GUIDELINES:

The exhibition is open to all members. Annual dues of \$40 are incurred each May and 2020-2021 dues must be paid up for eligibility to this show.

All submitted artwork must be original, completed within the last two years, without instructor supervision and appropriate for all ages. Class or workshop art, as well as artwork entered in a previous WTWS judged show are not eligible.

*All paintings must be done using Watermedia (watercolor, gouache, acrylics, watercolor inks, acrylic inks). *No oils, water-soluble oils, alcohol inks or computer generated art will be accepted.* Collaged paintings, created with only white papers, hand painted by the artist with watermedia will be accepted. *No "found" / colored / preprinted commercial papers will be allowed.* The paintings may be on paper, yupo, tyvek, watermedia board or canvas.

*Artwork on paper products require framing under glass, acrylic glass or Plexiglas, with a mat or floated, using artist's choice of mat color. **Or also acceptable** are artworks on paper that are permanently adhered to a gallery canvas or cradled board, sealed and protected with an archival varnish product, rather than a frame with glazing.

*Framed canvas / board, Watermedia board with side wood panels, and Gallery-wrapped canvas with sides finished to complement the painting are all acceptable. Wire hangers only. *No sawtooth hangers*.

All submitted artwork must remain for the duration of the show. To do otherwise puts our show facilities in a bind and ruins the integrity of our shows.

ENTRY FEES / CATEGORIES: Fees will be \$15 per entry or \$40 for 3, with a maximum of 3 entries. Checks are to be made payable to WTWS. There will be three categories for this show: Novice (0 – 5 years experience), Intermediate, and Advanced/Professional. *Combining of categories is possible at the discretion of WTWS, based on entries received.*

ENTRY PROCEDURE: All artists must complete the Exhibit Entry Form and a label sheet for their art piece(s). (Forms attached to this document.) Entry fees are non-refundable and must accompany the art works and entry form to the Garden and Arts Center on March 30th. Artists are welcomed to, but not required to, sell their work. *If selling*, artist must additionally present the W9 Form and City Vendor Form **, and a copy of his/her Texas Sales Tax ID Certificate. Selling Price needs to include 30% city commission. GAC will add sales tax to the artist's listed price at the time of sale and declare the tax. GAC will transact the sale and the artist will receive 70% of their listed price.

AWARDS: Over \$1000 Total Awards

She has recently been awarded the Artistic Excellence Award at the 2019 Wild Rivers Plein Air Festival, as well as the Artist Choice Award and the Wild Rivers Recreation Award. Her work has been accepted into several juried competitions, including receiving the American Impressionist Society 2018 Gamblin Award of Distinction and Plein Air Painters of New Mexico, Santa Fe Plein Air Fiesta 2018 2nd place.
